### SUMATRAN RHINOS

The Sumatran rhino is one of the three types of Asian rhino. There are only around 100 of them left in the wild and the population is very unstable. The forests where they live are illegally destroyed to make way for coffee and rice plantations. Various organisations are working with local governments to prevent hunting rhinos and to stop forests from being destroyed.

Not many people know that Sumatran rhinos are covered in hair! Baby rhinos have thick hair which turns red when they grow. By the time they're adults, the hair is thin and dark. Sumatran rhinos are the smallest of the living rhinos – up to 1.5 metres tall and can weigh 600 – 950 kilograms.

Sumatran rhinos are vegetarians. They consume lots of bamboo leaves, and enjoy munching on fruit, twigs and other parts of trees. However, they don't consume anything during the day. They prefer to do it in the dark – just before dawn and after sunset.
